De Los Angeles was amongst the purest shooters at the camp. He has supreme confidence in his shot, and that confidence is warranted. His mechanics are efficient with zero wasted motion, good knee bend and his balance is perfect. While he doesn't elevate much, his effortless quick release helps alleviate that deficiency. Not flustered by run outs, however, he needs space for the release at 6'2 and can be bothered by length. Stays within himself for the most part, playing to his strength behind the three-point arc and staying in constant motion off the ball. He'll never be mistaken for a premiere athlete, lacking the foot speed, quickness or explosiveness to be an offensive playmaker. De Los Angeles was engaged defensively, getting his hands on a number of loose balls and diving with no regard for his body. He has a magnet-like quality. Must protect the ball and not dribble straight up, as he was stripped on numerous occasions.
