Athletic small forward with an ultra-wiry 6'7 185 pound frame. Most of his field goal attempts came in the mid-range area, looking extremely comfortable shooting from a stand still or pulling up. Converted a high percentage between 15-18 feet. Displayed good elevation on his jumper with a high release for consistent clean looks. His jump shot is essentially unblockable. The remainder of his offensive damage was accomplished slashing to the hoop and getting to the free throw stripe. Hang time and body adjustments were impressive, allowing him to compensate for lack of muscle. Showed an unexpected dose of guard skills, leading a fastbreak and making a prudent, timely bounce pass for a layup. Tremendous wingspan and long strides. Great activity on the offensive glass utilizing his length and quick second bounce off the deck. Gary was badly outmuscled inside by Will Pratt, but that's a difficult matchup. He's not capable of guarding the post. Better suited to play the role of perimeter disruptor on the defensive end. Needs to improve core strength.
