New York, NY USA - Friday, May 27, 2011 – The 2011 New York Exposure Camp is an opportunity for aspiring professional basketball players to tryout, be evaluated by, and receive feedback from professional basketball coaches and scouts representing teams from the US and overseas. PSMHoops is presenting the camp and confirms the coaches and scouts from five leagues and teams will be in attendance. Local and national All-American and All-Conference selectees headline the list of participating players.

For the first time, PSMHoops has organized its 2011 New York Exposure Camp hosted at the John Jay College for Criminal Justice (899 10th Avenue in Manhattan). Full-length games will begin at 9am and will run until 1pm. With an expected 40 players attending from more than a 20 schools across the country, PSMHoops' Chief Talent Evaluator and tournament organizer, Noam Fishman, is excited about the opportunities available for players to further their careers.

“The New York Exposure Camp is the latest of six camps that we have run and the first in New York. I am looking forward to this camp because the talent level is so high and intriguing.
